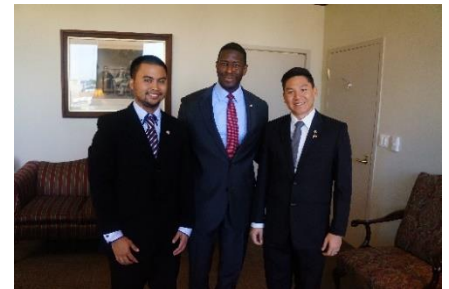


The Young Southeast Asian Leaders Initiative (YSEALI) Professional Fellows Program – Environmental Sustainability Cohort

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION The [International City/County Management Association \(ICMA\)](#), with funding from the [U.S. Department of State](#), offers the Professional Fellows Program – an opportunity for young professionals from Southeast Asia to learn about environmental sustainability through a four-week fellowship with a U.S. local government host.



Fellows are part of the State Department’s [Young Southeast Asian Leaders Initiative](#), a program that enables young leaders from ASEAN countries to work directly with American counterparts in non-profit organizations and state and local government offices across the United States for four weeks to enhance their practical expertise, leadership skills, and professional contacts to address challenges and create new opportunities in their home communities.

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS You must be a citizen and currently reside in Brunei, Myanmar, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Timor Leste, or Vietnam. Candidates must be between the ages of 25 and 35 and employed full-time with at least two years of professional experience. You must have a track record of making an impact in your community, institution or company. Additionally, you must be proficient in spoken and written English at the time of application.

TIMELINE The application period will begin Monday, October 1 to Friday, November 16, 2018. Only selected candidates will be contacted for an interview. The Fellowship dates are April 22 to May 31, 2019.
